

Having an CTS (Easy Read)

<p>appointment</p>	<p>You are coming to hospital for a CTS test. This looks at how your nerves work in your arms and hands and can see if a nerve is trapped or damaged, helping doctors work out how to look after you.</p>
	<p>First, we will clean small areas of your arms and hands. This will not hurt.</p>
	<p>Next, we will put some small stickers where we have cleaned on your arms and hands.</p>
	<p>We will join the stickers to the machine with wires and pass a small current through the stickers to your arms, which does not hurt but might tingle and make your muscles twitch a little for a very short time.</p>
<p>wetwipe</p>	<p>When the test is finished, we will take off the stickers and wipe your arms and hands again.</p>
<p>home</p>	<p>If you are not having any other tests, you can go home.</p>
